No matter how thorough you are, your ability to speak English is determined by your answers to questions normally asked by USCIS officers during the naturalization eligibility interview on Form. The interview will be held at the office of U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) that serves the region in which you live. You will receive only one. During the Citizenship interview, the USCIS officer asks the applicant up to 10 out of civics questions provided by USCIS on their website. Q. I Have My Citizenship Interview scheduled next month.
