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tive linguistics still stand separately. Among the reasons for this is Chomsky's insistence that his "is the only theory in existence so far that explains a certain category of facts" (p. 273), namely, his observations of a "steady state" of linguistic competence. Many will be disappointed by this lack of synthesis on the one hand, but will appreciate the many areas of agreement which have been highlighted on the other. In fact, Piaget sees "no major conflict between Chomsky's linguistics and my own psychology" (p. 57). Chomsky concludes (paradoxically in view of his statement quoted above) that all the discussion is conjectural and that "no hypothesis proposed today is likely to be true" (p. 273).

To the reviewer, who does not claim to possess more than a basic understanding of the theories involved, this is not an easy book to read partly because of the content and partly because of communicative style. Chomsky's comments are fairly clearly laid out, but, as may be obvious already, Piaget's views are difficult to extract. This difficulty is compounded by the fact that, as Mehler points out, Piaget's feelings on innateness seem to change over the course of the debate.

As the arguments depend on logic rather than empirical evidence, it would be useful to have their premises clearly laid out from the beginning. If the basic premises are unacceptable to the reader, then the discussion becomes an exercise in logic, not a scientific examination of evidence. It is likely that these largely unprovable and unobservable premises will be unacceptable to many.

Language and Learning is undeniably a valuable contribution to the cognitive sciences. As such, it will be of interest to those cognitive psychologists, linguists, speech therapists and others who wish to consider the question of the psychogenesis of knowledge.
